



MASTER'S IN NANOSCIENCE

MASTER THESIS DEFENSE GUIDE LINES

1. The Master Thesis defense will consist in the public presentation of the research work developed by the student during the Master program. Three members, who will be selected from the Master's staff, will compose the evaluation committee. A written manuscript (in English) must be delivered as well.
2. The oral presentation of the work will be in English. A slot of 20 minutes will be allocated for each student's presentation. After that, comments/questions by the evaluation committee will follow for about 10 minutes.
3. There will be up to three sessions for the Master Thesis defense in each academic year. The last of these sessions will be the second week of September. The dates for the other sessions will be announced every year in due time.
4. Once the dates for the defense are announced, each student will present a formal application to defend the Master Thesis by sending an e-mail to info@mscnano.eu. The following information will be included:
 - Name of the student
 - Title of the work
 - Name(s) of the supervisor(s)This formal application must be sent at least one month before the announced defense date.
5. Seven days before the announced defense date, each student must submit an electronic copy (pdf format) of the Master Thesis Document to the same address. (info@mscnano.eu)
6. The marks obtained by the students will be announced no later than seven days after the Master Thesis defense.
